Attendee Meeting Controls

Button	Description
 Unmute  Mute	Click to mute / unmute your microphone.
 Mute	Click the "up arrow" (next to the microphone icon) to open audio settings . Here you can change speaker and microphone settings.
 Start Video  Stop Video	Click to start / stop your camera.
 Stop Video	Click the "up arrow" (next to the camera icon) to open video settings . Here you can change your camera settings.
 Invite	Click to invite people during a meeting .
 Participants	Click to show a list of other participants in the meeting. From this panel you can raise your hand, change your display name, unmute or mute your microphone, claim host controls and more. See here for a full list of features available in this panel.
 Share Screen	Click to start sharing your desktop display or any window/application on your computer with others in the meeting.
 Chat	Click to open the Chat panel where you can start or respond to a chat .
 Record	Only the host or designated persons can record a meeting. See record your meeting for help with recording.
 Leave Meeting	Click to leave the meeting.

To provide nonverbal feedback to the host of the meeting:

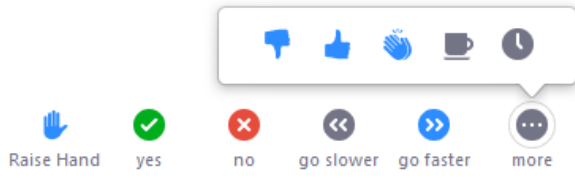
1. Join a Zoom meeting as a participant.

2. Click the **Participants** button.



3. Click one of the icons to provide feedback to the host. Click the icon again to remove it.

Note: You can only have one icon active at a time.
